DAY 1: MARRAKECH ARRIVAL AT MARRAKECH MENARA AIRPORT







Today, start your journey with your international outbound flight to Marrakech. On arrival at Marrakech airport, you will be met by your private chauffeur and take you to your riad. The rest of the day you can relax or discover the medina of Marrakech in the evening with your private english speaking Guide . You can stroll through the souq or try some of the delicious food served in the many local restaurants, from lamb tagine to sweet pastilla.

DAY 2: MARRAKECH SIGHTSEEING WITH PRIVATE OFFICIAL GUIDE

Your adventure "Best of Morocco" continues today with a private tour to discover the secrets of the Medina of Marrakech. Gain detailed information on the city's main attractions, including the artfully decorated 16th-century Saadian tombs, the Bahia Palace and the Koutoubia Mosque, which dominates the city skyline. This afternoon, explore the medina and the sougs, where you can watch

men and women working on their craft and learn about dyeing, tannery and coppersmithing techniques. The afternoon ends in Djemaa El Fna, the main square of Marrakech, where street performers entertain the masses and you can taste all sorts of food.



DAY 3: MARRAKECH - OUARZAZATE - AIT BEN HADDOU







You leave Marrakech at 9am to begin your Morocco desert tour to the south. You cross the High Atlas Mountains over the Tizi n 'Tichka Pass, a masterpiece of road construction that towers at 2260 meters altitude. Before being built by the French in 1936, the only other way to cross the High Atlas was along the route, followed by camel trains, and the zig-zag stretch of the road shows how tedious that was !!! .

Stop for lunch and visit the World Heritage site of Ait Ben Haddou, a magnificent red mud and straw village that sets the scene for many Hollywood film productions, and the final scenes of the TV series' series three, A Game of Thrones. You can also explore Ouarzazate, the home of Kasbah Taourirt, once owned by the powerful Glaoui family, who built their wealth on tax credits levied on camel caravans traveling between Marrakech and Timbuktu.

DAY 4 : SKOURA – RISSANI – MERZOUGA (ERG CHEBBI)



Further along the Dades Valley, visit the Todra Gorge on the way to Erfoud, on the edge of the Sahara Desert. From here you can travel on a short camel ride to the heart of the desert and stop to watch the sunset over the dunes, before embarking for a night under the stars in your luxury desert camp.

DAY 5: MERZOUGA (ERG CHEBBI) -ARFOUD - MIDDELT - IFRANE - FES



Today we head north to Fez and wake up early to climb a sand dune and watch the most spectacular sunrise of all time, illuminating a unique desert landscape. We drive past Rissani, via Erfoud, to reach the mountain town of Midelt. Then across the barren and rocky Middle Atlas, where many buildings have a Swiss Austrian style, this is Ifrane the Switzerland of Morocco.

Finally, we will arrive in the ancient city of Fes, the cultural, spiritual capital of Morocco and one of the most authentic medieval Islamic cities in the world. Your adventure for today ends here in your adorable riad, where you can rest and refresh yourself.

DAY 6: SIGHTSEEING TOUR IN FES: THE ANCIENT AND OLDEST MEDINA MOROCCO'S











The Moroccan spiritual cultural capital Fes is also home to many architectural and historic delights, including Medersa el-Attarine, a beautiful 700-year-old temple-like building once used for religious education and other educational purposes. The sprawling souks are also not to be missed, and best explored with a local guide who brings the moody narrow market streets to life and offers you a fun and immersive shopping spree.

Afterwards, treat yourself to a candlelit dinner in the stunning La Maison Bleue, where you can enjoy a celebration of traditional Moroccan cuisine accompanied by the harmonious sounds of local musicians - an authentic experience you will not forget.

DAY 7: FES - VOLUBILIS - MESKNES - RABAT - CASABLANCA











Spend the day with your private english speaking chauffeur and your priate guide to reimburse a visit to the Roman ruins of Volubilis and the Royal Meknes. The sprawling ruins show how big the Roman city was, and there are still many incredibly well-preserved mosaics on the floor. The impressive ruins

of the courthouse and the Capitoline Temple suggest that it was once a prosperous city. Meknes was once a capital of the kingdom, but has gradually fallen into ruin. Your tour guide will tell you about his eventful history, and you will see remnants of his former glory in the monumental archways of the city wall.

After lunch, you head to the capital Morocco Rabat. Once in Rabat you will be given a private tour of Imperial Rabat with Hassan's Tour and Mausoleum of Mohammed V and the enchanting Chellah. Then we continue our journey towards Casablanca, the economic capital of Morocco. The route to your hotel Four Seasons Casablanca, where you will spend your night, gives you the opportunity to visit the Hassan II Mosque, which is known for its breathtaking beauty.
