DAY 1: CASABLANCA ARRIVAL AT THE AIRPORT IN CASABLANCA (OR MARRAKESH)





Salam Alaykoum and welcome to Morocco

TAG 2: CASABLANCA - RABAT- CHAFCHAOUEN









After breakfast, you will be picked up by your own carefully selected chauffeur and driven to Chefchaouen, or "Chaouen" as it is called locally. You will have the opportunity to discover Rabat, places like Mohammed V Mausoleum, the charming Kasbah of the Oudayas and the Chellah, an ancient Roman city.

Chafchaouen is a visual delight in blue; Walls, doors, windows; Stairs, alleys and archways - all is a combination of soft pastel blue and deeper, stronger shades. This afternoon you can explore at your own pace or just relax. Outa el Hammam is the main square, and the place to watch the world go by. Stroll up the tiny, hip-piggeldy lanes off the touristy areas and find the city's everyday life.

DAY 3: CHAFCHAOUEN SIGHTSEEING TOUR - VOLUBILIS - MEKNES - FES















Today you can take a closer look at the "Blue City". Either on your own or take a local guide. Start your day in Chefchaouen's beautiful medina. Picturesque and uncrowded, this part of the city provides an excellent place to experience the city's street life. In the heart of the medina is the Plaza Utta el-Hammam, a perfect place to enjoy a drink in a shady sidewalk café.

We say goodbye to Chefchaouen and drive south to Volubilis, the most important and extensive remains of a Roman city in Morocco. You move on to Moulay Idriss, who looks like a sitting camel from a distance. Morocco's oldest city was founded by Moulay Idriss I in 789 after fleeing Mecca.

Finally, we become the ancient royal city of Fes, the cultural and spiritual capital of Morocco and one of the most authentic medieval Islamic cities in the world. Your adventure for today ends here in your beautiful oriental riad, where you can rest and refresh yourself.

DAY 4 : FES SIGHTSEEING TOUR * CULTURE / HISTORY / LOCALS & HAND CRAFT ON THE TRACK *











It's your chance to see the UNESCO protected Fez Medina through the eyes of a local, with your own private english speaking guide born in Fes. Your tour lasts from 10 am to 5:30 pm with a lunch break. Before leaving in the morning, discuss with your guide which attractions you would like to see, including the historic mosques, tanneries, and sougs.

If you've never been to Fez, let your private guide have a hand in designing your one-of-a-kind tour of Fes, and it'll be worth the while to reveal the secrets of the 9,000 labyrinthine streets and lanes that make up this amazing historic city - but do not worry, you will not be expected to go all of them! For sure you can also spend one more night in Fes to enjoy a private cooking class with a local family in Fez the morning, then start your second afternoon exploring the city.

Or take the afternoon and just go to Hammam followed by a good dose of massage. A magical effect and unique feeling!







DAY 5: IFRANE - MIDELT - ARFOUD - RISSANI - MERZOUGA - ERG CHEBBI









Your discovery in southern Morocco begins today. You will drive through the Atlas mountains to the edge of the Sahara - a long but interesting journey. You drive via Ifrane Switzerland Morocco, over the landscape of the Mittelatlases into the desert, where you arrive in time to observe the unique sunset over the dunes.

Today you will experience one of the most memorable moments of your Moroccan adventure as you make your way to the dunes of the Moroccan region of Erg Chebbi in the Sahara Desert for an unforgettable night under the stars.

A camel ride along the dunes takes you to your luxurious camp, with its Bedouin-style tents and thick Moroccan rugs to keep the sand between your toes. A rich tagine is your dinner, which is eaten by candlelight. You will probably drift off as you watch the twinkling stars.

DAY 6: ERG CHEBBI - MERZOUGA - TOUDRA GORGES - SKOURA











Get up at dawn and watch the sun begin its daily bow with a cool blue morning sky as it illuminates the shadows of the desert before turning into a glowing fireball. Your first stop on the way is Tinjedad, where lunch is served. Time permitting, visit Ksar El Khorbat, a covered city whose dark alleyways are punctuated by intermittent sunshine and home to a charming cultural museum.

Tonight stay in the palm grove of Skoura, known as the Valley of the Kasbahs.

DAY 7: SKOURA - OUARZAZATE - AIT BENHADDOU - MARRAKESCH



When you leave Skoura, your road heads towards Ouarzazate, the Hollywood of Africa, where Atlas Studios is considered one of the largest film studios in the world. Although many of our travelers do not choose to visit the film studio, the Kasbah de Taorirt in the city is worth a stop. It was once owned by the Glaoui family, one of the richest and most powerful in the region, whose enormous wealth was partly due to levies on the camel trains passing through their territory with gold, spices and slaves from Timbuktu on their journey to the markets of Marrakech and beyond, were.

Arriving in Ait Ben Haddou, a UNESCO World Heritage Site that is not only the best example in the area of a walled city protected by kasbahs, the homes of the rich and powerful, but was also the backdrop of many Hollywood blockbusters and great historical Television programs, including Gladiator and Lawrence of Arabia.

From Ait Ben Haddou you can continue in the less visited area of Telouet. Here you can meander over the former palace of the family Glaoui. The final leg of today's journey will take you across the High Atlas Mountains on the impressive Zigzag of the Tiz n Tichka Pass to finally arrive in Marrakech, where you will have time to truly relax and recover from the journey before dinner served in the riad.

At the Berber Museum you can admire objects once belonging to the Berber tribes, while the Yves Saint Laurent 'Love Gallery' displays vivid paintings created by the French fashion designer.

The YSL Museum opened last year is a highlight and a must for every fashionist as well as every visitor to Marrakech.

Or take the afternoon and just go to Hammam, take your time for your beauty, give your body and mind complete relaxation, believe me this is one of the best experiences Morocco has to offer.

DAY 9: HIGHT ATLAS MOUNTAINS DAY EXCURSION * THE GREAT CULTURE OF THE BERBERS *







Just an hour from Marrakech you will find the beautiful valleys at the foot of the Atlas Mountains. Here live Berber, a North African ethnic group and most of the Moroccan population.

If you follow this road, you will see red valleys traversed by various mountain streams, Oued. The changing colors, suitable for the seasons, illuminate the orchards where the herds of the village graze. When you arrive in one of the Berber villages, you will be welcomed into the home of the local family and given the unique opportunity to take a look at the simple and authentic way of life that has been alive for more than a thousand years. You will visit a Berber house where village women and Berbers weave rugs to meet ever-increasing national and international demands. True inspiring craftsmanship of the Berbers and an ancient tradition.

You will be invited to lunch with a real Berber family to share the food with you and you will experience how hospitable the Berbers really are.

Of course, you can also have lunch at Kasbah Tamodot, the most beautiful Kasbah in Morocco owned by Richard Branson.
